

For the attention of foreign citizens - students and entrants

"Luhansk Taras Shevchenko National University " inform that according to the letter of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine №1 / 9-423 from 06.08.2020 "On some features of the beginning of the educational process in the 2020/2021 academic year" subject to quarantine on the territory of Ukraine, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine plans **to continue the reception of foreign citizens until December 15, 2020 (instead of November 1, 2020).**

Admission of foreign citizens will take place in person, training can be in full-time, distance or part-time forms of education, taking into account the requirements of higher education standards.

According to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of July 22, 2020 №641 "On the establishment of quarantine and implementation of enhanced anti-epidemic measures in the area with a significant spread of acute respiratory disease COVID-19 caused by coronavirus SARS-CoV-2" on the territory of Ukraine for the period of quarantine is prohibited:

- crossing the state border by foreigners and stateless persons (except for foreigners, stateless persons permanently residing in Ukraine and persons recognized as refugees, or persons in need of additional protection) without an existing insurance policy (certificate) issued by an insurance company registered in Ukraine or a foreign insurance company that has a representative office in Ukraine or a contractual relationship with an insurance company - a partner in Ukraine (assistance), and covers the costs associated with the treatment of COVID-19, observation, and is valid for the period of stay in Ukraine;
- in order to counteract the spread of COVID-19 and monitor self-isolation, the electronic service "Action at Home" of the Unified State Web Portal of Electronic Services (hereinafter - the system) is used;
- persons crossing the state border from the state or being citizens (subjects) of states with a significant spread of COVID-19 are subject to self-isolation (except for persons under 12 years of age, are citizens (subjects) of states with a significant spread of COVID-19 and have not been on territory of such states during the last 14 days.

A country with a high prevalence of COVID-19 is a country that has one of the following characteristics:

- the number of new cases of COVID-19 per 100 thousand populations in the last 14 days exceeds the number of such cases in Ukraine;

- The increase in new cases of COVID-19 in the country in the last 14 days compared to the previous 14 days is more than 30 percent.

The list of countries with a high prevalence of COVID-19 is compiled by the Ministry of Health and reviewed every seven days.

A person subject to self-isolation, in connection with the crossing of the state border, is obliged to install and activate the mobile application of the system (hereinafter - the mobile application). If it is impossible to install such an application, the person is subject to observation;

- the term of self-isolation is 14 days for persons who have crossed the state border and are self-isolated using the system through a mobile application, from the moment of crossing the state border;
- persons in need of self-isolation are obliged to be constantly in the place of self-isolation determined by them, to refrain from contact with persons other than those with whom they live together;
- stay in the observatories of foreigners and stateless persons (except for foreigners, stateless persons permanently residing in Ukraine and persons recognized as refugees, or persons in need of additional protection) is paid by the insurer in accordance with the insurance policy (certificate) the costs associated with the observation, or such persons themselves;
- self-isolation, observation of a person in connection with crossing the state border (who came from the state or is a citizen (subject) of the state with a significant spread of COVID-19) **is terminated in case of a negative test result on COVID-19 by polymerase chain reaction after crossing the state border or no later than 48 hours before crossing.**
