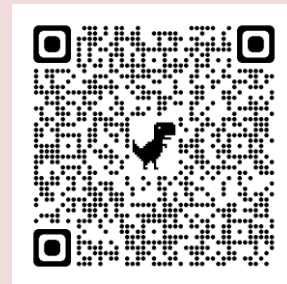

FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE it is necessary:

- 1) 1) Fill in the form for participation in the conference (link: <https://forms.gle/DVRfe5TnwysYNQxa7>) – *no later than May 20, 2023*;
- 2) 2) Send the electronic version of the publication – *no later than May 20, 2023*;



The organizational fee for participation in the conference is **UAH 200**. (a collection of conference materials in pdf format and certificates of the conference participant indicating the number, hours and ECTS credits in electronic form will be sent to the authors by e-mail no earlier than 21 days after the date of the conference).

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES

- **The text is typed** in Microsoft Word format (*.docx, *.rtf) with pen No. 12 (set – Times New Roman) on A-4 paper; margins (top and bottom – 2.5 cm, right – 2.5 cm, left – 2.5 cm); upper footer - 1.25 cm, lower - 1.5 cm; line spacing – 1.0, paragraph indent – 1.25 cm.
- **Volume** – up to 18,000 printed characters.
- **The title of the publication** is given in the middle of the line in capital letters, the font is bold.
- After the title, in the upper right corner, **information about the author of the article** is provided: surname, first name, patronymic, scientific degree, academic title, position, full name of the institution (educational institution, organization), city, country, e-mail address (from the next line).
- Below (for scientists) – **ORCID ID** (a personal code that must be obtained by filling out the form at the link: <https://orcid.org/register>) in the format <https://orcid.org/0000-0000-0000-0000>
- **Students** write a paper in co-authorship with a scientific supervisor (no more than 3 co-authors) specifying the surname, first name, patronymic, course of study, specialty, level of higher education, institution of higher education, city, country, e-mail address.
- **The content of the article:** setting the problem; analysis of the latest research and publications; selection of previously unresolved parts of the general problem; definition of the research methodology; presentation of the main research material with a certain justification of the obtained scientific results; conclusions from this study and prospects for further research in this direction.
- **All the listed elements must be stylistically and graphically presented in the text.**
- Before the text of the article, **2 annotations** of 15 lines each (in Ukrainian and English) surname, first name and patronymic of the author, the title of the article and keywords (5-8 terms) are submitted.
- The text of the abstract must meet the general requirements for the style of the abstract (for example, “The article defines... Presents... Characterizes... Reveals...” etc.). Editing the annotation in English using online services (for example, Google translate, etc.) is unacceptable! In the abstract, it is necessary to justify the relevance of the research, indicate its purpose, the main results obtained by the author(s) personally.

- **References to sources** are given in round brackets, including the author's last name and the year of publication (Kremen, 2012) or (Kremen, 2012; Romenets, 2013). If citations, statistics, etc. are used, the reference page number is indicated (Kremen, 2012, p. 24).
- Tables and other non-text objects should be numbered and centered in the text.
- **The bibliography and, if necessary, notes** are submitted at the end of the article after the heading “References” (without a colon) **in the order of citation** and are drawn up in accordance with the standards of the international style of design of publications of the American Psychological Association (APA Style <http://www.apastyle.org>). Bibliographic sources are presented consecutively, without paragraph separation; the name of the author of the work (or the first word of its title) is highlighted in bold.
- A list of used literature / used sources in Latin (References) is added to the article. Registration in accordance with the **APA**:

Last name, initials of the author. (Year of publication). The title of the article is transliterated [Title of the article in English]. Name of the magazine. Journal number (volume or issue). Pages. URL or DOI. In parentheses, the original language is indicated as follows: [in Ukrainian].

References by the author(s) of the article to textbooks, study guides and popular scientific literature are undesirable.

The recommended site for transliteration from the Ukrainian language is <http://ukrlit.org/transliteratsiia>

Only scientific publications on the subject of the conference, which have not been made public before, are accepted for publication. All papers will be checked for plagiarism (papers that do not pass the check will not be published!).

The electronic version of the article is stored in the *.docx format, which should be called the serial number of the thematic direction of the conference and the surname of the first author, for example: 1_Dubovy.docx (1 – thematic direction of the conference; Dubovy – the surname of the first author).

Attention! The materials are printed in the author's editorial office in the languages of the originals, for the presentation, content and authenticity of which the authors are responsible.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject material that does not correspond to the thematic areas of the conference, designed in violation of the above requirements, sent after April 20, 2023.

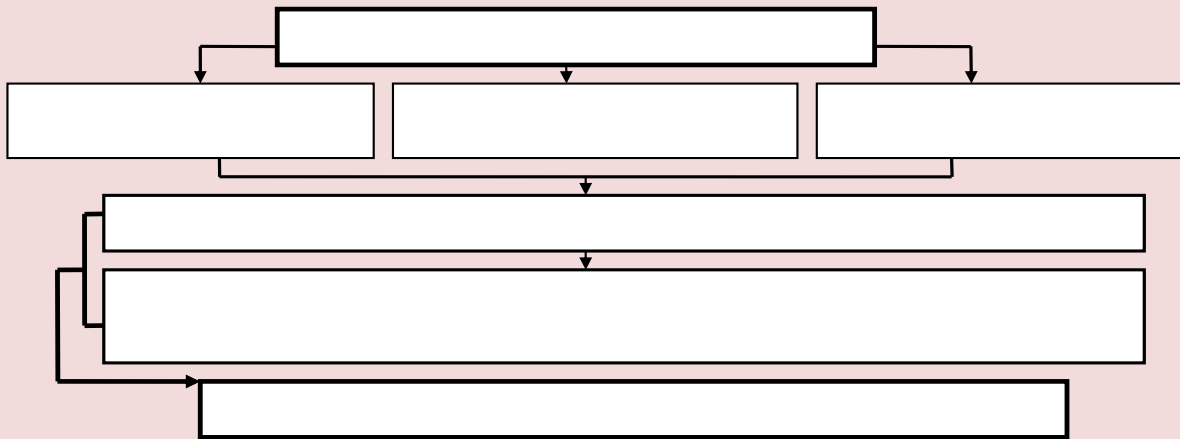
